On 8<sup>th</sup> June FSSAI had come out with the advisory on product safety testing of all instant noodle products in India. At that time we had sought clarification from FSSAI since Top Ramen product approval is pending with the regulator. They have requested us to withdraw the product until they give the product approval. We hope to get the approval soon from FSSAI and be back in the market providing safe and affordable food products as we have done for over 24 years.

Top Ramen has been in the Indian market since 1991 and is loved by millions of Indian consumers. The brand has never had any product safety issue or product recall in the last 24 years. It is manufactured in company owned factories with the highest quality and safety standards in keeping with its Japanese heritage.
